Discuss and Possibly Act Upon Resolution No. R-23-016 Canvassing the Returns and Declaring the Results of the General Election Held on May 6, 2023 for the Purpose of Electing One Mayor – At Large; One Councilmember for Place 2 – Ward 2; Councilmember for Place 4 – Ward 4 to the City Council of the City of Brenham, Texas Each for a Four-Year Term**

City Secretary Jeana Bellinger presented this item. Bellinger explained that this Resolution is to canvass the official results of the General Election held on May 6, 2023. Bellinger stated that the results of the General Election were as follows:

- Mayor – At Large (1,888)
 - Atwood Kenjura: 60.1% of the total votes (1,135)
 - Keith Hofmann: 39.9% of the total votes (753)
- Councilmember for Place 2 – Ward 2 (236)
 - Albert Wright: 100% of the total votes (236)
- Councilmember for Place 4 – Ward 4 (293)
 - Adonna Saunders: 100% of the total votes (293)

A motion was made by Councilmember Cook and seconded by Councilmember Canales to approve Resolution No. R-23-016 canvassing the returns and declaring the results of the General Election Held on May 6, 2023 for the purpose of electing a Mayor – At Large (Atwood Kenjura); One Councilmember for Place 2 – Ward 2 (Albert Wright); and One Councilmember for Place 4 – Ward 4 (Adonna Saunders) to the City Council of the City of Brenham, Texas each for a four-year term.
